

PROPOSED PLANS AND PROGRAMS FOR 2019

1. REGISTRATION OF MOTOR VEHICLES

- Establishment and construction of the government owned Motor Vehicle Inspection Center.(MVIC)
-Integration of MVIS database with LTO IT system.
- Accreditation of Private Motor Vehicle Inspection Center.
- Online or web-based applications and approval of accreditation for Manufacturers, Assemblers, Importers, Rebuilders and/or Dealers (MAIRDs).
- Do-It-Yourself (DIY) processing of Certificate of Stock Reported (CSR) at the workplace of the manufacturers, assemblers and/or importers.
- Online registration of brand new Completely Built Unit (CBU) motor vehicles

2. LICENSING OF DRIVERS AND CONDUCTORS

- Implement a point-demerit system to encourage drivers to strictly obey rules and regulations on traffic
- Enhancement of driver's license test questionnaires relevant to the type of motor vehicle/license applied for.
- Enhancement of course content for driving school.
- Full automation of driver's license practical examination.
- Availability of on-line lecture modules (Non-Professional, Professional and Conductors) for driver's license prior to the conduct of license examination.
- Conduct of regular training or seminar for professional driver's license holders.

3. ENFORCEMENT

- Develop module on road safety education for primary and secondary schools
- Enhancement of the existing training module (audio video) presentation for holders of professional driver's license and deputized enforcers.
- Capacity buildings of LTO enforcers and deputized agents

- Intensified campaign on the implementation of RA 8750, RA10666, RA10586, and RA 10913
- Intensify enforcement of RA 4136, JAO 2014-01, RA 8749, 8750, 8794, 10586, 10666, 10913, and 10916.
